

1. Executive Summary

Through this deliverable, we seek to appoint Dr. Constantin Vică as GreenME Ethics Advisor specialised in research ethics and EU data protection law.

He will be consulted on matters related to the recruitment of vulnerable individuals, and personal data processing.

He will submit a report to the EC at the end of each reporting period, starting in M18, specifying how the consortium has addressed these issues and any new ethics issues that might have arisen.

1.1. External Ethics Advisor: CV, experience, and responsibilities within the GreenME project

Dr. Vică is currently working as an assistant professor at the Faculty of Philosophy of the University of Bucharest. Moreover, he is a communication coordinator at the Research center in applied ethics and he is working as a researcher within the ENHATEC project-Future Ethics at the same center of the University of Bucharest. He was previously a teaching assistant at the same faculty (2013-2016), an Erasmus coordinator (2014-2018), and he participated as a researcher in several projects (COMORE project-collective moral responsibility and AI, ICONIC project - Longitudinal analyses of coauthorship networks and citations in academia, INEMTEC project - The reliability of moral institution, and NORMEV project - Emergence and evolution of social norms). He defended his PhD Thesis in 2011 and he is a Doctor in Philosophy by the Philosophy Doctoral School - University of Bucharest.

Within the framework of the GreenME Project, he will be addressed in relation to any topic related to ethics and he would be responsible for writing three different reports linked to the different work packages in which research ethics is involved:

- WP2 "Assessment of the current status of green care": this WP assesses the state of "green care" integration in each partner country, using primarily in-depth interviews of stakeholders and review of documents.
- WP3 "Effectiveness, cost-effectiveness, and causal pathways of nature-based therapy":
 Evaluation trials of nature-based therapy programs in partner countries, for which we will be collecting survey data from participants in each program following an epidemiological study design (details of which will be co-designed with partners).
- WP4 "The role of nature-in-everyday-life and nature-based health promotion": A
 socioecological study looking at the existence and access to nature-in-everyday-life in
 specific geographic areas in each partner country. For this, we will use existing spatial
 and sociodemographic data; a population-based survey; and a green space audit tool to
 assess green space quality.



Dr. Vică will be responsible of writing three reports which are:

- Deliverable D7.2 OEI Requirement No. 2 (M18): Linked to RP1, from month 1 to month 18 (18M). At this point, WP2) Survey data will be collected and analyzed; WP3) the protocols will be made for the design and data collection tools and procedures for the evaluation trials of nature-based therapy cases (but data collection itself is schedule to start in M18); WP4) Survey will be designed and launched but data collection will not be complete.
- Deliverable D7.3 OEI Requirement No. 3 (M36): Linked to RP2: from month 19 to month 36 (18M). WP2) will be complete; WP3) Data collection will be complete, and analysis will be in process; WP4) Data collection will be complete, and analysis will be in process.
- **Deliverable D7.4 OEI Requirement No. 4 (M48):** Linked to RP3: from month 36 to month 48 (12 M): End of project, all WPs complete.
